Dear neighbour,

Alkington 14 public footpath crossing enhancement

We wanted to let you know that we'll soon be upgrading the existing footpath crossing at Alkington 14, installing a new crossing surface, fencing, access ramps and steps.

The **crossing will be closed** between **Monday 16 April** and **Friday 27 May**. We know there's never an ideal time to do this, but we won't be able to provide a safe route across during this time. We want to apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause.

Our preparation work will need to be carried out overnight whilst fewer trains are running, which will enable us to carry out the core works during the day and help reduce noise overnight. We've listed our planned shifts below, but please note this can change.

Monday 18 – Friday 22 April	Four overnight shifts, 9pm – 7am each night
Monday 25 – Friday 29 April	Five daytime shifts, 7am – 5.30pm each day
Monday 2 – Friday 6 May	Five daytime shifts, 7am – 5.30pm each day
Monday 9 – Friday 13 May	Five daytime shifts, 7am – 5.30pm each day
Monday 16 – Friday 20 May	Five daytime shifts, 7am – 5.30pm each day
Monday 23 – Friday 27 May	Five daytime shifts, 7am – 5.30pm each day

We know we're working near your home and that this work may generate some noise at times. We'll work hard to keep any unnecessary noise to a minimum, but want to apologise in advance if we do disturb you.
